

**TEMPORARY USE PERMIT
FRAZEE SCHOOL FOREST**

I hereby apply for a permit for temporary use and access to the real property known as the Frazee School Forest legally described as follows:

The Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) and the South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S½ NW¼) of Section 12, Township 138 North of Range 40 West of the 5th P.M. in Becker County, Minnesota.

I understand that permission for use and access to the Frazee School Forest is strictly subject to full compliance with the following rules, requirements and conditions:

1. Each person who wishes to use and have access to the Frazee School Forest must apply for and receive a permit before entry is permitted, must check out a key, and must fill out an activity request form that lists the purpose of the requested use and access.
2. Hunting or use or possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon on school property, including but not limited to the Frazee School Forest, is strictly prohibited by the laws of the State of Minnesota and may constitute a criminal offense.
3. Any firearm or other dangerous weapon transported with the permittee across the School Forest Property must be in a motor vehicle and done so in strict compliance with the ISD #23 School Weapons Policy, Minn. Stat. 609.66 Subd.1d(d)(3); Minn. Stat. 624.714 and Minn. Stat. 624.715 which require, at minimum, that the firearm or dangerous weapon is:
 - a) Unloaded and in the closed trunk of a motor vehicle; or
 - b) Unloaded and in a gun case expressly made to contain a firearm or dangerous weapon, and the case fully encloses the firearm or dangerous weapon by being zipped, snapped, buckled, tied or otherwise fastened, and without any portion of the firearm or dangerous weapon exposed.
4. Permission is limited to the following times:
 - a) Daily access. Provided no school activities are planned for the school forest on a day, permittees may check out a key at the administration building after 8:00 a.m. and must return that key no later than 8:00 a.m. the following day.
 - b) Weekend access. Provided no school activities are planned for the school forest on a weekend, permittees may check out a key at the administration building after

3:30 p.m. and before 4:30 p.m. on a Friday and must return that key no later than 8:00 a.m. the following Monday.

5. No permittee is allowed to duplicate or have in that permittee's possession any key to the School Forest except as provided above. Permittees may not transfer or give the key issued to them to any other person. Loss or failure to timely return a key will require the permittee to pay all expenses of changing the lock on the School Forest gate and issuance of new keys.

6. The permittee acknowledges that the permittee has no legal right, other than by virtue of any permit herein granted, to use or access the land known as the Frazee School Forest and that the permission herein granted is revocable at any time without cause by the School Administration and its authorized agents and employees.

7. Permittee assumes all risk of loss, injury or damage to permittee, permittee's property or others while exercising the permission granted herein and agrees to defend and indemnify ISD #23 from any liability it may suffer as a consequence of the exercise of the permission granted herein. Permittee will maintain property damage and personal injury liability insurance coverage for all vehicles used to travel across the Frazee School Forest, with coverage amounts reasonably satisfactory to ISD #23 and shall provide written verification of such coverage to ISD #23 for all such vehicles

8. ISD#23 reserves the right to restrict or deny use or access to any person or persons for any reason. Snowmobiles, ATV's and other motorized recreational vehicles are prohibited. No vehicle travel will be permitted when road damage is possible. No snowplowing of the road is permitted. Any permittee damaging the road or other property within the School Forest is personally liable for the cost of repair or replacement. Permittees shall immediately lock the gate after using the gate for entry or exit to or from the School Forest.

9. No alcohol or tobacco may be used on school property. Use of the property and the validity of this permit is conditioned upon strict compliance with the ISD #23 School Forest Policy.

10. Any violation of this permit will result in revocation of this permit, which in the discretion of the Administration may be permanent

I understand and agree to the above stated limitations and conditions and I request an issuance of a permit to use and access the real property known as the Frazee School Forest:
