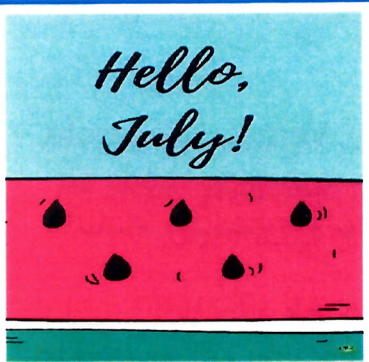

Mayor's Message

Vergas will be receiving funding as part of the federal American Rescue Plan Act. The funding is to assist communities in recovery from the negative impacts of covid-19 and support infrastructure improvements. Though there are criteria for spending, the funds are broader in nature and there is a 5-year window for spending. Estimate the allocation to Vergas to be in the range of \$36,000-\$38,000.
