Second Annual Vergas Small Town Christmas Event

Christmas season is right around the corner, and again this year we would like to work together with the community to host a Small- Town Christmas event that captures and helps reinforce the true meaning of Christmas!



Decorating of the City Streets/ Parks/ Seating Areas:

The Community Club plans to put up ten trees (donated by Ditterich Family Farms), along with wreaths and swags along the sidewalks and sitting areas throughout the town. Along with the trees, we have volunteers to decorate the planters and to add a splash of color and Christmas decorations to the City Park and Peterson Park. The Community Club has provided a budget that can be used to pay for lights and any trees/ greenery and other decorations that are needed. We would love to have some volunteers and plan to do a lot of the decorating Saturday, November 17th.

The City will work with Ottertail Power to decorate the light poles and big tree in front of Franklin Fence.

Decorating of the Store Fronts and Churches: Once again, we would like to request that each business and church decorate their building fronts, etc. and have the lights ready to turn on by November 24th.

Event – Small Town

Christmas: We plan to hold our Small-Town Christmas event on Saturday, November 24th that will start at 4:30 and run through 6:30 pm.



Once again, we will have a live nativity featuring animals from Trowbridge Zoo along with volunteers from our churches to dress as the main nativity characters. We have lined up warming stations along with cocoa and cookies for everyone (the Loon's Nest is donating most of

the cookies and cocoa for us and many Community Club members are also donating cookies). We would like some of our churches to help with Christmas caroling and will have a short Christmas ceremony, and hope to get a special visit from Santa again.

This year we are adding a couple of fun events!

- Denise and Bryan Laymon will be offering sleigh rides throughout the town; whether snow or no snow they have it covered as they have skis or wheels for their wagon! How fun!
- Also, Otter Coffee & Ice Cream will be hosting a Ginger Bread Decorating Contest outside of the City Office by the 'cocoa and cookie' area. We encourage everyone to participate; either by making a house or by voting on your favorites! Every vote will cost \$1.00 and will be donated to the Community Club to help pay for more fun events like this one! We will have prizes!

Home Decorating Contests: This year the Community Club will be spear-heading the decorating contests for home owners! The plan is to hold one contest for those that live in town and



another for those that live in the country. Those that live in the city limits will all be included automatically and will be judged by a committee, those that live out of the city limits will require nominations be submitted to Natalie's Serendipity. Judging will happen the last week in November/ first week in December. Prizes will be provided for first, second and third winners. (Prizes include gift cards from the local businesses).

Communication of Events: We ask each business and church to help us in this venture, by not only decorating their fronts but also by communicating to your customers and congregations the November 24th 'Small Town Christmas' event as well as the decorating contest for home owners.

Overall Goal: Let's work together again this year to ensure our small town is filled with love and family spirit over the holiday season!
